

At the cemetery: Resource Packet: Statistical Investigation Area 8

Southern Cemetery – Blocks 2 and 5.



Notes for Teachers about Area 8

This statistical investigation area includes some interesting headstones that indicate different events, occupations and life styles of the people who are buried here. Encourage students to observe the different kinds of headstones that they see. People buried in this area represent both those who were well-off and those who were less so. Several people in this block were first settlers in Dunedin. There are also a number of events that include accident and war involvement that have claimed the lives of some of the people commemorated here. This small area represents a particularly rich tapestry of human life in Dunedin's past.

What is of interest?

1. The Cargill and Reynolds memorials are included in this block. Capt William Cargill **2/6-8** was a founding father of Dunedin. William Reynolds **2/ 4-5** also had a significant role to play in the establishment of Dunedin and Otago.
2. First World War involvement is commemorated on the Chadwick headstone. **2A7**
3. Several accidents are also commemorated. There is Stephens **2/16**, Homen **5/52**, and Blomfield **5/44**.

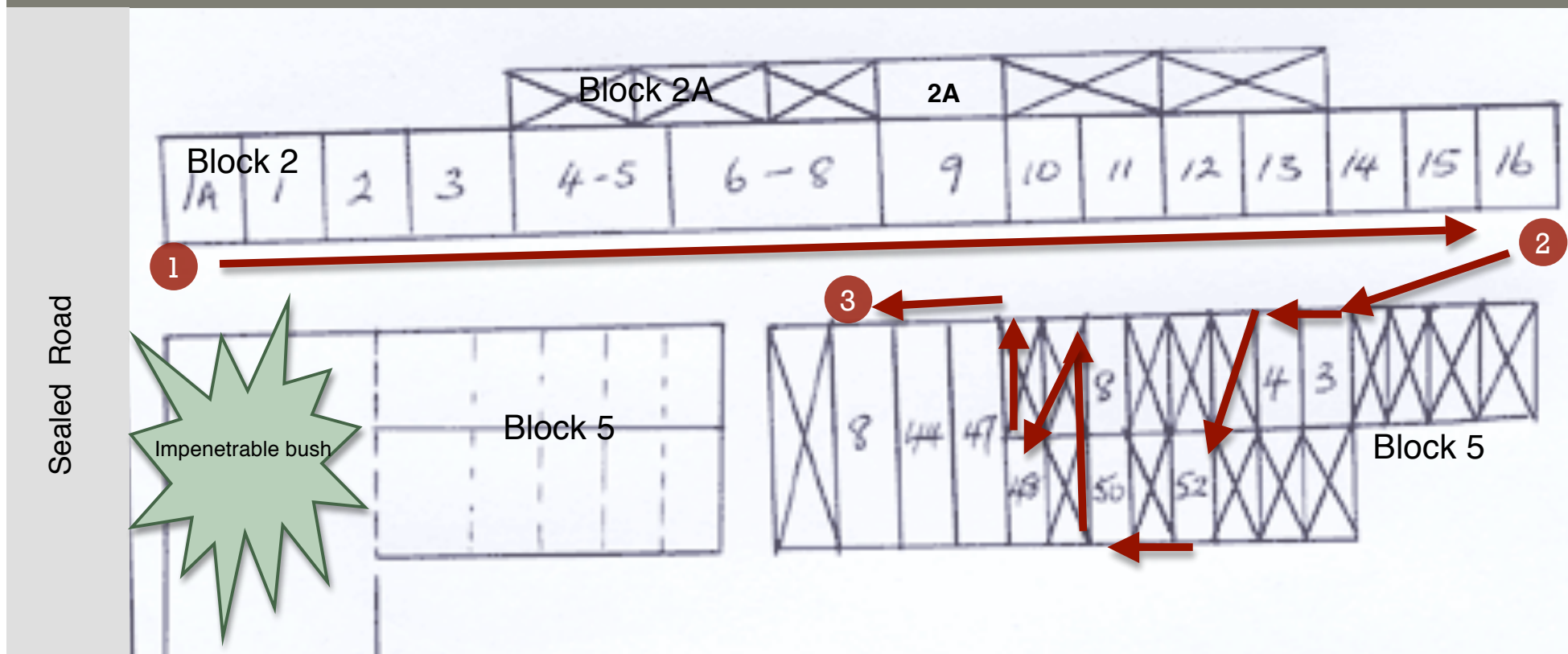

Instructions

Start at Plot 1A and work along the block to the end of the block – the Jenkinson headstone at Plot 16. Don't forget the headstone behind the Shand Memorial. Turn around and work along the block behind you recording name, age and date of death of the readable headstones. Block 5 work across the block Record the details in order of Plots 3,4,52,50,8,48, 47, 44 and 8 in that order.

Finish at point three just before the narrow grass path.

Students write the name (they can use initials where they do not need to look up any further information on those listed on the inscription), date of death and age.
